## <u>The Art Effect Presents the Reel Expressions International Film Festival – Free for Under 21</u>

**POUGHKEEPSIE, NY** – Celebrating its seventh year, the <u>Reel Expressions International Film Festival</u> features a variety of short films created by emerging filmmakers from the Hudson Valley and around the world. Reel Expressions takes place on Saturday, April 6th from 5:00pm-7:30pm at the Bardavon 1869 Opera House, 35 Market St, Poughkeepsie, NY. Doors open at 5:00pm, with light refreshments and cinemagraphic photo ops, and the film showcase begins promptly at 5:30pm.

Out of over 100 films submitted and judged by a panel of industry professionals and local youth producers, only 15 made the final cut for the festival. These short films express the voices of up-and-coming filmmakers, while addressing issues like political commentary, gender and identity, mental and physical health, and more.

Festival goers can expect to see documentaries, experimental films, animations, and dramas in this year's lineup. Finalists from all over the world produced films for the festival, with pieces made in South Korea, Spain, Canada, and the United States — including films created by youth in Poughkeepsie.

The full lineup of films in the showcase has been confirmed and is attached to this release.

Winners will be announced at the end of the screening, where they will be awarded cash prizes and a Sparky Trophy, with first prize taking home \$500. Before viewing the films, festival goers can enjoy dynamic media activities, light refreshments, and giveaways.

This showcase encourages youth creativity, invigorates our local community through the arts, and showcases the incredible work done by the next generation of media-makers. This festival is created for audiences at least 13 years of age. Tickets are free for individuals under 21, with a suggested donation of \$10 for adults.
